Gene Youngmann talked to the membership about the next years Western Federation Watercolor Society show. The prospectus is in the Collage. Entries are due November 1. They already have frames, which will save them a great deal of money, so they have stipulations on the sizes. They are listed in the prospectus. The paintings will have to be weighted to fit these frame sizes. This means the mats will be larger at the bottom than the sides or top.

The Summer of Watercolor was very successful and fifteen paintings were sold in Arvada. Catalogs for WFWS and the State shows are still available for \$10. Twenty-nine frames remain unsold, with the most expensive costing \$43. They may be purchased from Carla Rouse.
