

CWS GENERAL MEETING
January 16, 2007

CALL TO ORDER:

President Gene Youngmann called the general meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

CWS now has 388 members.

BOARD AND COMMITTEE REPORTS:

The CWS Board approved revisions on policies. Also approved was a \$550 donation to the Arvada Center's public art program. CWS will receive a plaque near the new artwork.

Exhibitions: Randy Hale reported that the proposal to the Lab has been submitted and we are now waiting for a response. We are pursuing a long-term contract for shows.

Pat and Kate discussed the Member Show: Frames cannot be larger than 1 ½" wide. Slides for publication must be given to Pat Foster by the middle of February. Notice of intent is due 3/15. Paintings can be brought to the March meeting for delivery.

WFWS Delegate: Diane Fechenbach reported CWS has entered more than twice as many as years before with 134 artists entering 305 paintings. From 12/28 to 1/13 there have been 347 digital entries from 159 artists, 95 images from 41 artists. It takes Gene Youngmann 15 minutes to log and download each image. There are a total of 652 entries so far.
