

CWS GENERAL MEETING MINUTES  
October 19, 2010

CALL TO ORDER: President Sydney Eitel called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

-The Members Show will be held at the Michener Library at the University of Northern Colorado. Postcards are available tonight on the back table.

-The State Show will be held at Foothills Art Center in Golden, Colorado. Exhibit dates are March 17 – May 2, 2011. Deadline for entries is December 14, 2010. The prospectus will be in the November *Collage*. All entries will be digital and not slides.

    - March will be a critique.
  - Paul answered questions about the upcoming "Show, Tell & Sell" Show. He let the membership know that small items would sell well, participants will handle sales and reporting of sales taxes individually, and that no commission will be taken on sales by CWS.
  - Paul gave a short bio of the meeting's presenter, Stan Miller, and welcomed him.
